

## Max's Maths Market Adventure

*Learning objective: To use fronted adverbials to describe when or how things happen.*

A fronted adverbial goes at the start of a sentence. It tells us more about the action. Remember to put a comma after the fronted adverbial! Choose a word from the box to start each sentence.

Max the monkey is at the market. He wants to buy some fruit. He counts his coins to see if he has enough money. He needs to buy apples for his friends.

*Word bank: Quietly · Yesterday · Suddenly · Happily · Carefully*

**1. Max walked to the market. Add a word from the box to the start: \_\_\_\_\_, Max walked to the market. (2 marks)**

**2. Max counted his 50p coins. Add a word from the box to the start: \_\_\_\_\_, Max counted his 50p coins. (2 marks)**

**3. The fruit was very tasty. Add a word from the box to the start: \_\_\_\_\_, the fruit was very tasty. (2 marks)**

**4. Max found a shiny coin. Add a word from the box to the start: \_\_\_\_\_, Max found a shiny coin. (2 marks)**

**Draw: Draw Max the monkey holding a bag of red apples at the market. Draw some 10p and 50p coins next to him.**



*Extension challenge: Can you write one sentence about Pip the caterpillar using a fronted adverbial? Start with 'Slowly,'.*
