

Max the Monkey's Sentence Building Adventure

Learning objective: To understand how to use capital letters at the start of sentences and full stops at the end of sentences.

Max the Monkey is sorting his maths puzzles. Help him fix his sentences by adding a capital letter at the start and a full stop at the end. Remember, every sentence needs a friend at the beginning and a friend at the end!

1. the monkey is happy
2. max eats a banana
3. we play in the park

Word bank: the · monkey · is · happy · max · eats · a · banana · we · play · in · the · park

1. Rewrite this sentence correctly: the monkey is happy (2 marks)

2. Rewrite this sentence correctly: max eats a banana (2 marks)

3. Rewrite this sentence correctly: we play in the park (2 marks)

4. Why do we put a full stop at the end of a sentence? (1 mark)

5. Max has 2 bananas and buys 1 more for £1. How many bananas does he have now? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw Max the Monkey sitting in a tree holding his favourite fruit. Make sure you draw a clear, large full stop on the ground beneath the tree!



Extension challenge: Can you write your own sentence about an animal? Don't forget to use a capital letter at the start and a full stop at the end!
