

Max the Monkey's Grammar Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use adjectives to describe nouns in sentences.

Help Max the Monkey describe the items he finds in the jungle. Read the questions carefully and use your best handwriting.

Word bank: shiny · soft · large · bright · bumpy · crunchy

1. Max found a fruit. Choose an adjective from the word bank to describe a fruit. Write a full sentence about the fruit. (2 marks)

2. Circle the adjective in this sentence: 'The monkey climbed the tall tree.' (1 mark)

3. Add a describing word to this sentence to make it more interesting: 'Max saw a _____ butterfly.' (1 mark)

4. Max has a banana that cost £1. Write a sentence describing the banana using one adjective and the price. (2 marks)

5. Look at these two nouns: 'leaf' and 'rock'. Write one adjective for each one. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw Max the Monkey holding a bright, shiny object he found in the jungle. Label your drawing with two adjectives.



Extension challenge: Think of an animal. Can you write three sentences about it using a different adjective in each sentence?
