

Grammar Explorer Flashcards with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To identify and understand key grammatical terms including word classes, conjunctions, and sentence structures suitable for Year 3.

Use these flashcards to test your grammar knowledge. Read the term or question on the front, think of the answer, and then check the back to see if you are correct!

What is a Noun?

A noun is a word that names a person, place, animal, or thing, such as 'Max', 'park', or 'banana'.

What is an Adjective?

An adjective is a word that describes a noun, like 'fluffy', 'bright', or 'enormous'.

What is a Verb?

A verb is an action word or a state of being, such as 'jump', 'think', 'run', or 'is'.

What is an Adverb?

An adverb describes how a verb happens, often ending in -ly, like 'quickly', 'happily', or 'softly'.

What is a Conjunction?

A conjunction joins words, phrases, or clauses together, such as 'and', 'but', 'so', or 'because'.

What is a Determiner?

A determiner introduces a noun, such as 'the', 'a', 'an', 'my', or 'some'.

What is a Preposition?

A preposition shows the position or direction of something, like 'above', 'behind', 'under', or 'into'.

What is a Fronted Adverbial?

A word or phrase at the start of a sentence that describes how, when, or where an action happens, followed by a comma.

Which letters are the vowels?

The vowels are a, e, i, o, and u.

What is a Consonant?

A consonant is any letter that is not a vowel, such as b, c, d, f, g, etc.

Max bought a banana for £1 and an apple for 50p. How much did he spend?

Max spent £1.50.

Identify the verb in this sentence: Max climbed the tree.

The verb is 'climbed'.
