

Myths and Legends: Create Your Own Hero

Learning objective: To use descriptive language to design a mythical hero and label their key features.

Follow the steps below to draw your own hero from a legend. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a full-body picture of a hero in the centre of the page. Use a clear, bold style like a comic book. Ensure the hero has at least one 'legendary' item, such as a glowing shield or a patterned cape. Leave space around the edges of your hero to draw lines for labels.



Label words: shield · cape · crest · armour · amulet · legendary · brave · mythical

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw your hero in the space below. Give them a piece of clothing or an item that looks like it belongs in a legend.
2. Step 2: Label your hero. Use at least three words from the word bank to point to parts of your drawing.
3. Step 3: Write one sentence to describe your hero. (Sentence starter: My hero is called...)
4. Step 4: What is your hero's special power? Write it here.
