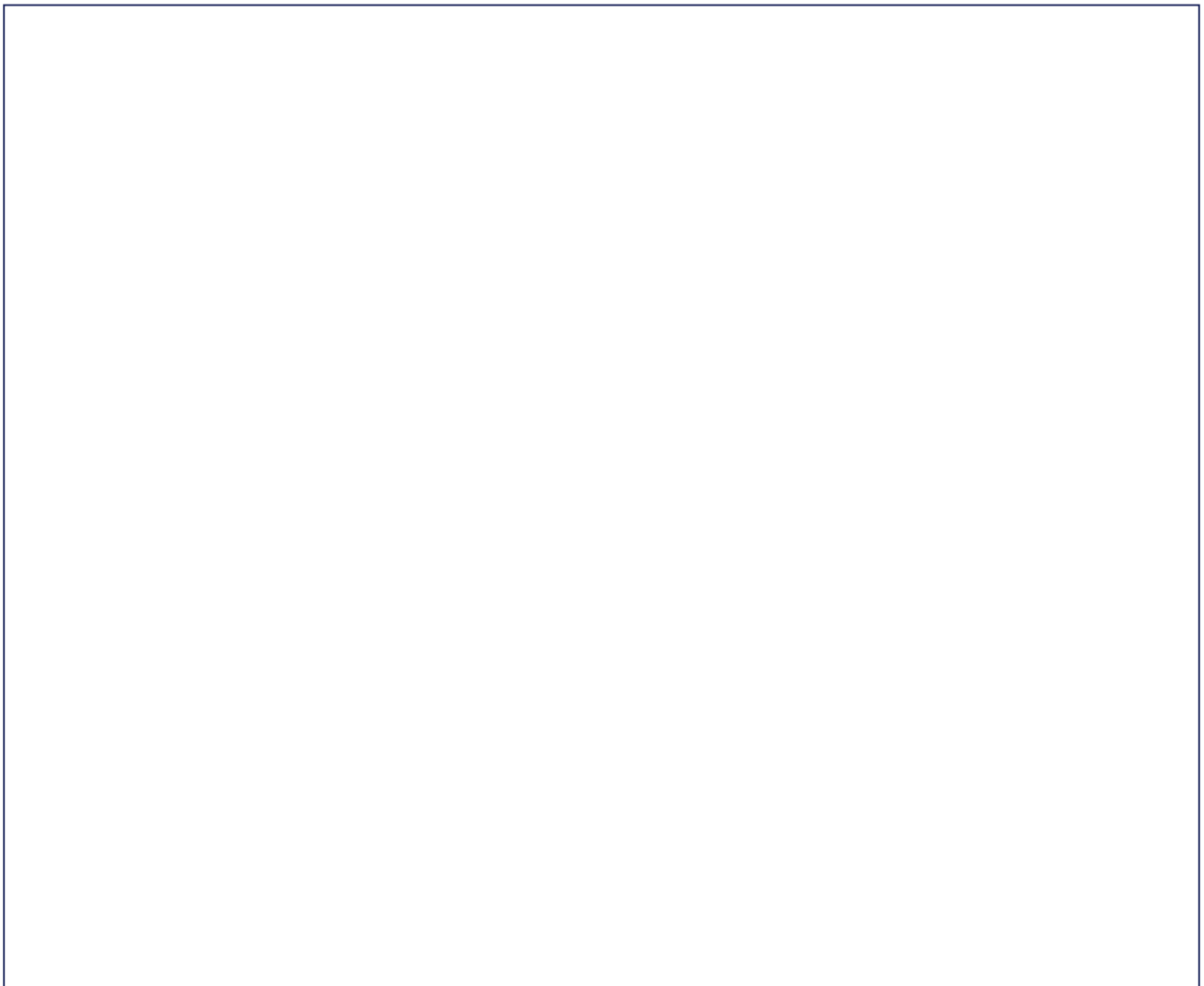


Reporting the News with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To identify and draw the key features of a newspaper front page.

Max the Monkey is writing a newspaper report about a mystery in the jungle! Follow the steps below to draw your own newspaper front page layout. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a newspaper front page layout on a blank piece of paper. Use a ruler to make straight boxes. Include a large space for a headline at the top, a square box for a photo in the centre, and lines for your written report. Make your drawing neat and clear, just like a real reporter would!



Label words: Headline · Photograph · Caption · Byline · Date

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large box at the top of your page for the Headline. What is your exciting news story?
2. Step 2: Draw a space for a Photograph in the middle of your page. Label the 'Caption' space underneath it.
3. Step 3: Add a 'Byline' near the top. Who is the reporter writing this story?
4. Step 4: Draw a small box for the 'Date' so the reader knows when the news happened.
