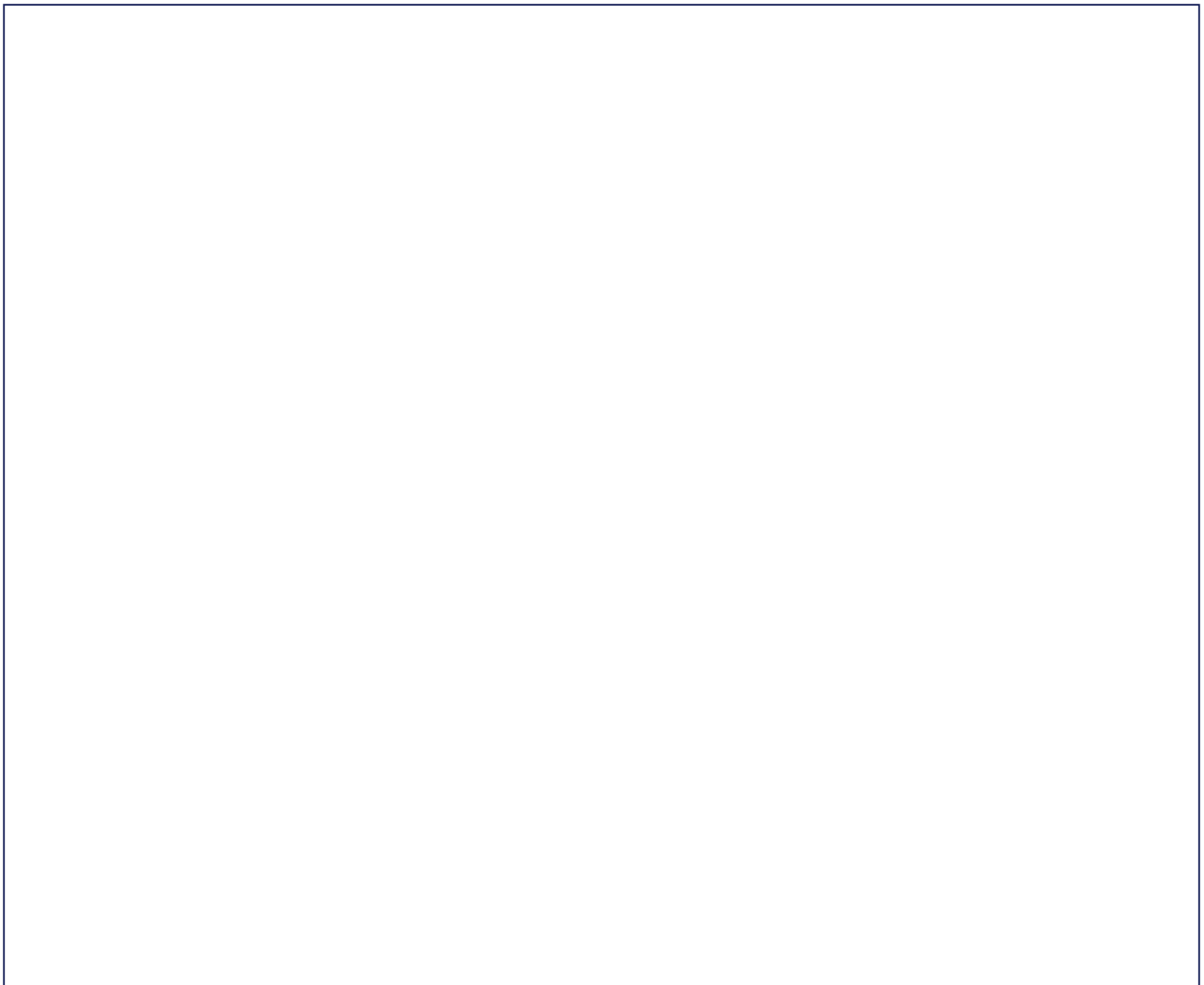


Design a Creature Report

Learning objective: To identify and use the features of a non-chronological report by planning a creature profile.

Follow the steps below to design your own imaginary creature. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing. Keep your sentences short and clear.

Draw: Draw a large, clear picture of an imaginary creature in a blank square space. Use a simple, bold style. Around the creature, leave white space to write labels. Ensure there is enough room to draw a small environment (like a tree or a cave) for the creature to live in.



Label words: Habitat · Diet · Appearance · Fact box · Heading · Sub-heading

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw your imaginary creature in the middle of the box. Give it a name.
2. Step 2: Draw a line to the creature's fur or skin. Label this 'Appearance'.
3. Step 3: Draw a small forest or pond in the corner. Label this 'Habitat'.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence about what your creature eats. Use the word 'Diet'.
