

My Animal Fact-File: A Non-Chronological Report

Learning objective: To write a non-chronological report using subheadings and technical vocabulary.

Hello! I am Nova the owl. Today, you are going to write a report about an animal. Use the boxes below to help you organise your facts. Remember to write in clear sentences. Use the word bank if you get stuck!

Word bank: habitat · diet · appearance · nocturnal · mammal · species · feature · interesting fact

1. Introduction: Write the name of your animal and tell the reader what group of animals it belongs to (e.g., mammal, bird, reptile). (2 marks)

2. Appearance: Describe what your animal looks like. Think about its colour, size, and any special body features. (2 marks)

3. Habitat: Where does your animal live? Describe its home (e.g., forest, ocean, desert). (2 marks)

4. Diet: What does your animal eat? Is it a carnivore, herbivore, or omnivore? (2 marks)

5. Amazing Fact: Write one surprising thing about your animal that makes it special. (2 marks)
