

Max and Zara's Wonderful World of Words

Jump into language with Max and Zara – Nouns name things, Verbs name the action!

- A Noun is a naming word. It names a person (like a teacher), a place (like a park), or a thing (like a pencil).
- A Verb is a doing word. It tells us what the noun is doing, such as running, singing, or eating.
- In the sentence 'The elephant walks', 'elephant' is the noun because it is the thing.
- In the sentence 'The elephant walks', 'walks' is the verb because it is the action.
- Zara the zebra uses nouns to name the colours she paints, and verbs to describe how her brush moves!

Did you know? Did you know? Every sentence needs at least one verb to make it go! Without verbs, our sentences would be as still as a statue. Max the monkey loves verbs because they show him how to climb, jump, and swing!
