

Max and Zara's Word Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use nouns (naming words) and verbs (doing words) correctly in sentences.

Read the words in the bank below. Sort them into the correct groups and use them to help Max the Monkey and Zara the Zebra finish their sentences.

Max the Monkey and Zara the Zebra are playing in the park. Max loves to move, and Zara loves to create art!

Word bank: run · banana · jump · paintbrush · dance · pencil · climb · zebra

1. A noun is a person, place, or thing. Pick two nouns from the word bank and write them here. (2 marks)

2. A verb is a doing word. Write two verbs from the word bank that show how Max might move. (2 marks)

3. Fill in the blank: Zara uses her _____ to draw a pattern. (1 mark)

4. Fill in the blank: Max likes to _____ up the tall tree. (1 mark)

5. Write your own sentence using one noun and one verb from the word bank. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max holding a banana and Zara holding a paintbrush. Can you label the noun and the verb in your drawing?



Extension challenge: Can you think of one more noun and one more verb that are not in the word bank? Write them down and explain why they fit into their groups!
