

Max and Pip's Noun and Verb Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and distinguish between nouns (naming words) and verbs (action words) in sentences.

Read the front of each flashcard to see if it is a noun or a verb. Then, check the answer on the back to see if you were right! Max the monkey loves these puzzles, and Pip the caterpillar wants to collect all the words.

What is a noun?

A noun is a naming word for a person, place, or thing.

What is a verb?

A verb is an action word, like jumping, eating, or thinking.

Is 'monkey' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a living thing).

Is 'climb' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).

Is 'book' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a thing).

Is 'read' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).

Identify the noun in this sentence: 'Pip eats a leaf.'

Pip (or leaf).

Identify the verb in this sentence: 'Pip eats a leaf.'

eats.

Is 'garden' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a place).

Is 'run' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).

Is 'pencil' a noun or a verb?

Noun (it is a thing).

Is 'write' a noun or a verb?

Verb (it is an action).
