

Max the Monkey's Word Hunt

Learning objective: To identify and use nouns and verbs correctly in sentences.

Help Max the Monkey sort his jungle findings! A noun is a person, place, or thing. A verb is an action word (something you can do).

Word bank: swing · banana · climb · tree · jump · monkey · leaf · run

1. Look at the word bank. Write the four nouns in the box below. (4 marks)

2. Look at the word bank. Write the four verbs in the box below. (4 marks)

3. Circle the noun and underline the verb in this sentence: The lion sleeps under the big tree. (2 marks)

4. Write your own sentence about Pip the caterpillar. Use one noun and one verb. (2 marks)

5. Max found a coin worth 50p. Is 'coin' a noun or a verb? Explain how you know. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the Monkey in the jungle. Label one noun (like 'branch') and one verb (like 'eating') in your drawing.



Extension challenge: Choose two nouns and two verbs from the word bank and write a short story, no longer than three sentences, about an adventure in the jungle.
