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**3. Write a short sentence that could be added to the 'Morning Activities' paragraph. (2 marks)**

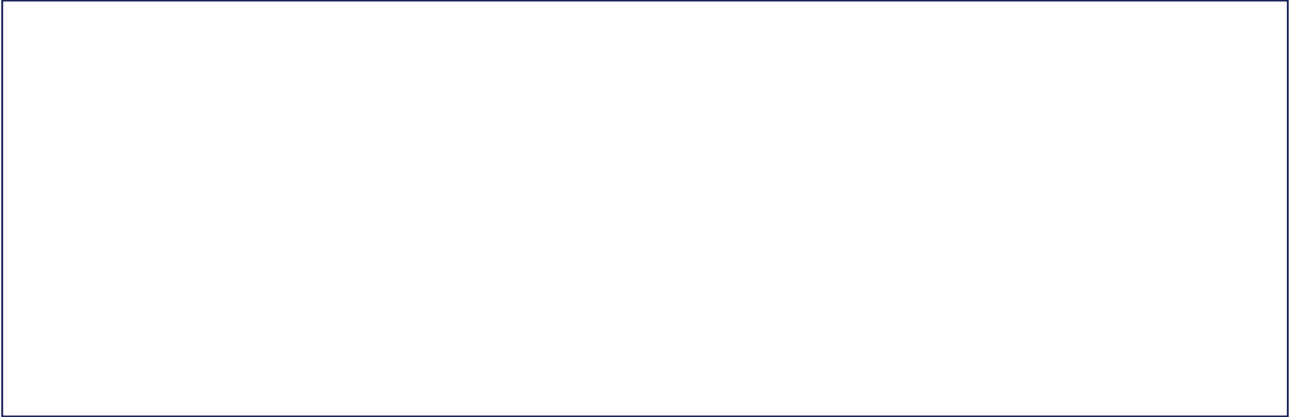
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**4. Write a short sentence that could be added to the 'Afternoon Fun' paragraph. (2 marks)**
