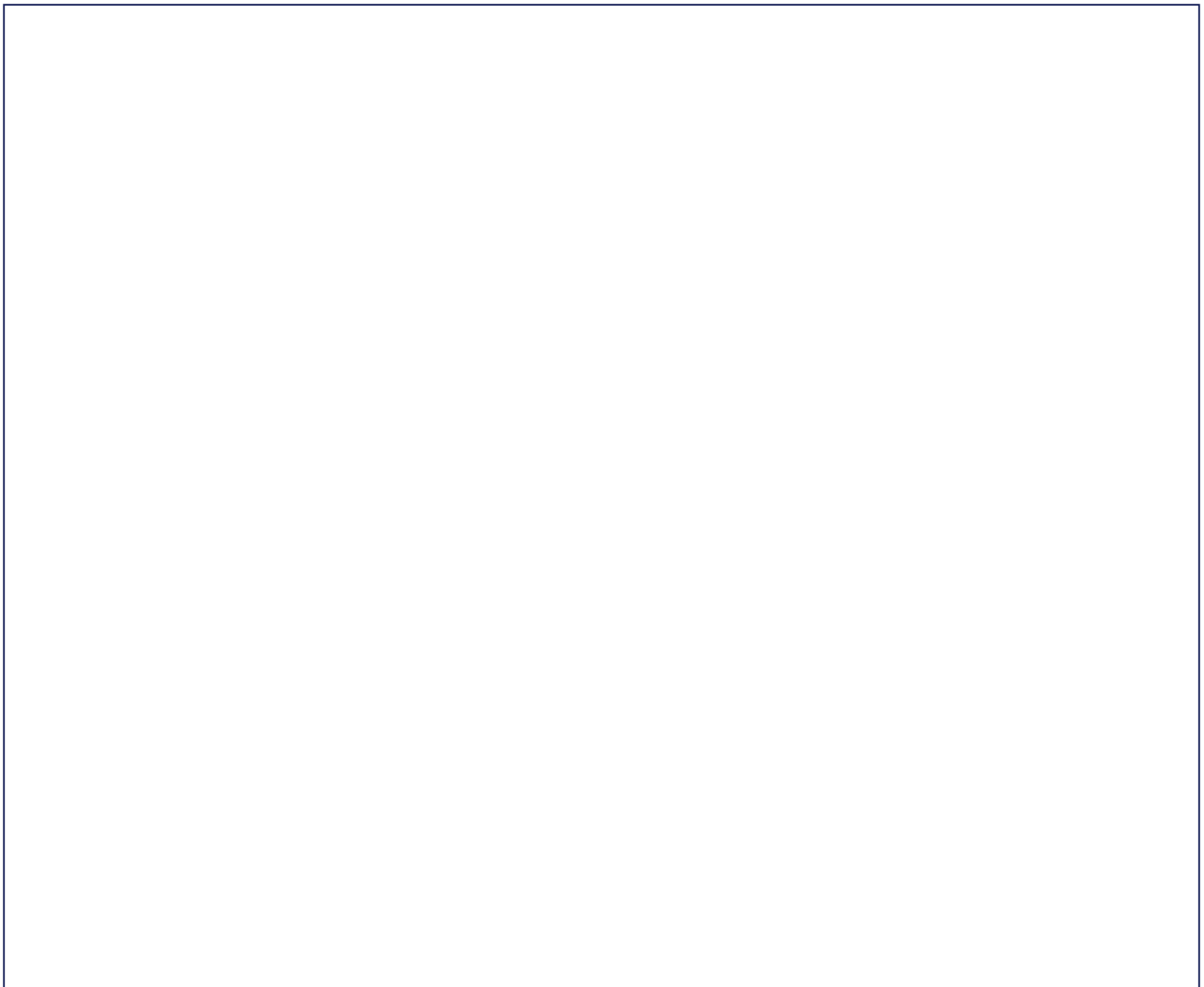


Setting the Scene: A Playscript Adventure

Learning objective: To understand how to visual a stage setting for a playscript by drawing a scene for Max the monkey.

Max the monkey is writing a play about a secret jungle maths laboratory. Use the drawing space to show what his stage looks like. Follow the steps below to help you draw the scene.

Draw: Draw a stage view of a jungle classroom. Include a wooden desk in the centre, a large tree on the left side of the stage, and Max the monkey holding a pencil. Use bright colours to show the jungle leaves and clear shapes for the maths equipment on the desk.



Label words: Stage · Prop · Character · Setting · Background

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw the setting. Where does Max's play take place? Draw a jungle laboratory with trees and a desk.
2. Step 2: Draw Max the monkey standing in the middle of the stage.
3. Step 3: Add one prop to the desk, like a giant calculator or a map.
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using words from the word bank.
