

Leo the Poet's Garden

Learning objective: To recognise that poetry uses descriptive language and to identify features of a poem.

Read the fun facts about poetry below, then colour in Leo the lion writing his poem in the garden. Label the parts of the poem as shown in the diagram.

Colour this: A friendly lion named Leo sitting on a grassy patch in a garden, holding a large quill pen and a scroll of parchment. The scroll has lines of a poem written on it in clear, large print. Around Leo are colourful flowers, a buzzing bee, and a bright sun in the corner. There is a clear 'Title' space at the top of the scroll and boxes with arrows pointing to the end of the lines for the child to label the rhyming words.



Steps:

1. Label the 'rhyming word' at the end of the line in Leo's poem.
2. Label the 'title' of the poem at the top of the page.
