- A poem is made of lines and stanzas, which are like small groups of sentences.
- Rhyming words sound the same at the end, like 'cat' and 'hat'.
- Rhythm is the steady beat you feel when you read a poem out loud.
- Poets choose special words to help you see, hear, and feel the story.
- You can write a poem about anything, from a buzzing bee to a shiny coin worth £1.

Did you know? Did you know? Poetry does not always have to rhyme! Some poems are written just to share a feeling or describe a beautiful sunset, like the ones Leo the Lion writes in his notebook.
