

My Book Review with Pip the Caterpillar

Learning objective: To develop reading comprehension skills by recalling key details and expressing personal opinions about a story.

Read a story with your teacher or at home. Once you have finished, use this template to tell Pip the Caterpillar all about your book. Write your answers in the boxes and draw your favourite part of the story in the space provided.

Word bank: character · favourite · happy · funny · exciting · beginning · middle · end

1. Book Title: What is the name of the story you read today? (2 marks)

2. Main Character: Who is the story about? Write their name or describe them. (2 marks)

3. What happened first? Tell me how the story started. (2 marks)

4. What happened at the end? Did the story have a happy ending? (2 marks)

5. My Opinion: Did you like this book? Why or why not? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite scene from the book you just read. Think about the colours and the characters you saw on the pages.



Extension challenge: Can you tell a friend or family member one thing you learned from the book, or one part that made you laugh?
