

My Book Review with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To express personal responses to a text and identify key information in a story.

Read your favourite book today. Use this template to tell Max the Monkey all about it! Think about the characters, the story, and what you liked best. Write your answers clearly and check your spellings.

1. Book Title and Author: Write the name of the book you read and who wrote it. (2 marks)

2. Who is the main character?: Describe the main character in the story. What are they like? (3 marks)

3. What happens in the story?: Tell me about the beginning, the middle, and how the story finishes. (4 marks)

4. What was your favourite part?: Explain why you liked this part of the story the most. (3 marks)

5. Would you recommend this book?: Tell a friend why they should (or should not) read this book. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of the most exciting scene from the book you read.



Extension challenge: Max the Monkey loves maths puzzles! If this book cost £5 and you paid with a £10 note, how much change would you get back? Show your working out.
