

BookFlik Character Profile: Create Your Own Hero

Learning objective: To develop reading comprehension and descriptive writing skills by creating an original character based on a text.

Read the story provided by your teacher. Choose one of the characters from the text and fill in this profile. Think carefully about how the author describes their personality, appearance, and actions. Use evidence from the text to support your answers.

Word bank: personality · characteristic · appearance · motivation · infer · evidence · adjectives · traits

1. Character Name and First Impression: Who is the character and what was your first impression of them when they were introduced? (2 marks)

2. Physical Appearance: Describe how the character looks. Use at least two adjectives and explain how these details help you picture them. (3 marks)

3. Personality and Traits: What is the character like on the inside? Give an example of a choice they made in the story that proves this. (3 marks)

4. The Character's Goal: What does this character want to achieve by the end of the story? What is standing in their way? (2 marks)

5. Author's Choice: Why do you think the author gave this character these specific traits? How would the story change if they were different? (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph predicting what this character might do next if the story were to continue for another chapter. Use clues from the text to keep their actions in character!
