

Pip's Spelling Garden

Learning objective: To practise spelling common exception words and phonemes through creative colouring and labelling.

Colour in Pip the caterpillar and his garden. Look at the spelling words hidden on the flower petals and colour them in carefully. Write the names of the items in the garden on the lines provided.

Colour this: A large, friendly cartoon caterpillar named Pip wearing a tiny pair of glasses, sitting on a leaf. He is surrounded by five large, simple daisy-shaped flowers. Each flower petal has a letter written on it clearly (forming the words 'the', 'said', 'was', 'he', and 'she').
