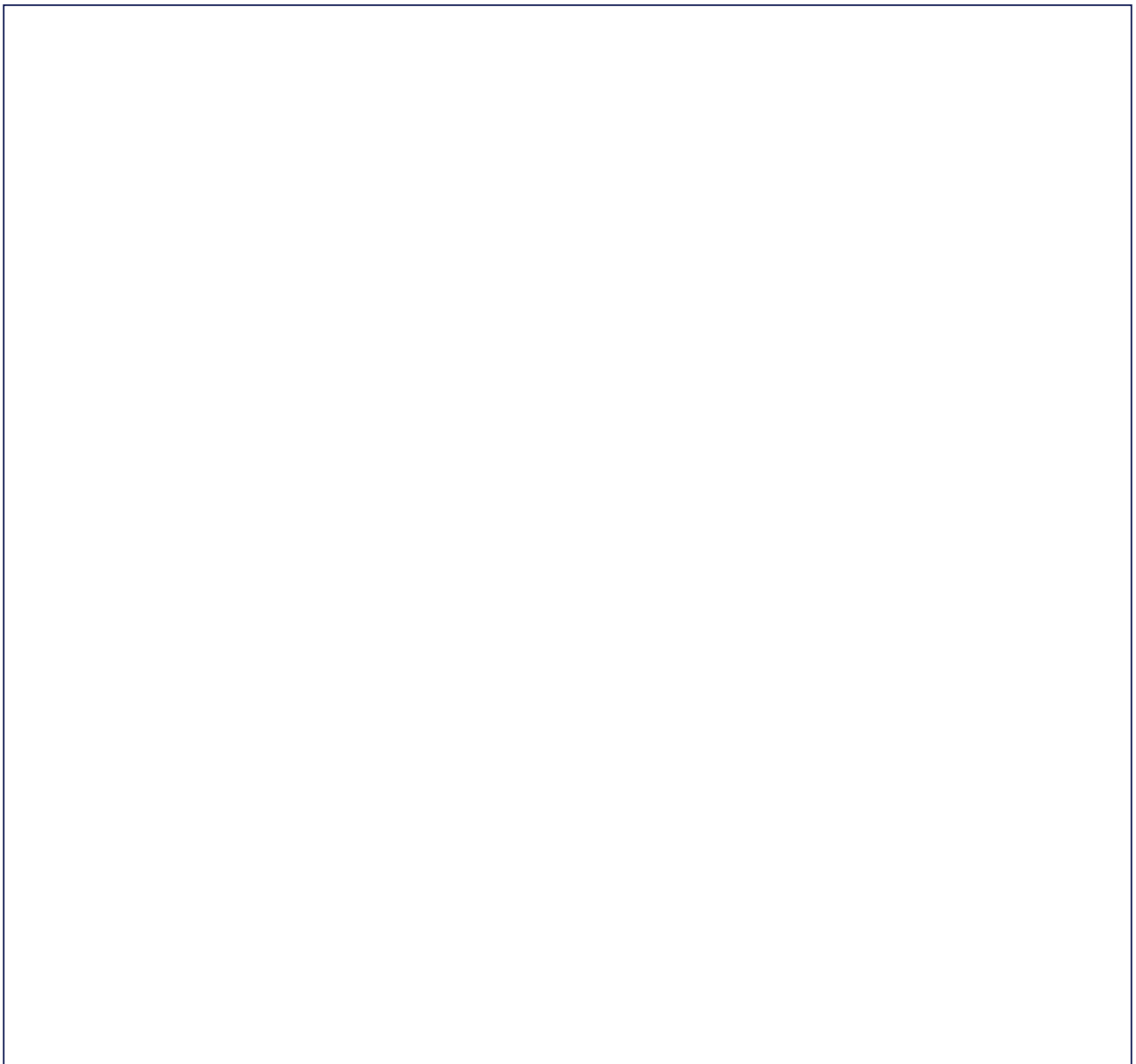


Pip's Spelling Garden

Learning objective: To practise identifying and spelling common Year 2 words within a creative context.

Read the fun facts, then colour in the scene. Use your best handwriting to label the parts of the garden as requested below.

Colour this: A friendly, smiling caterpillar named Pip wearing tiny round glasses, curled up on a large, broad leaf. Surrounding Pip are several large, cartoon-style garden flowers. On the petals of the largest flower, the letters B-E-C-A-U-S-E are clearly printed. Other flowers have blank petals for the child to write their own spelling words. There is a watering can in the corner and a bright sun in the sky. The lines should be bold and clear for easy colouring.



Steps:

1. Label the caterpillar in the picture with the name 'Pip'.
2. Label the large flower that has the word 'BECAUSE' written on its petals.
