

Max's Maths Shop Spelling Challenge

Learning objective: To practise spelling words ending in -tion, -sion, and -cian, and using the suffix -ed and -ing correctly.

Help Max the monkey organise his shop! Read each question carefully and check your spelling rules before you write your answers.

Max has been busy in his shop. He has sorted all his items into boxes. He uses his maths skills to make sure everything is in the right place, but he needs your help with his labels!

Word bank: action · station · musician · decided · hopping · jumping · toss · boss

1. Max has a toy robot that performs a special move. Can you spell the word that means 'doing something' that ends in -tion? (1 mark)

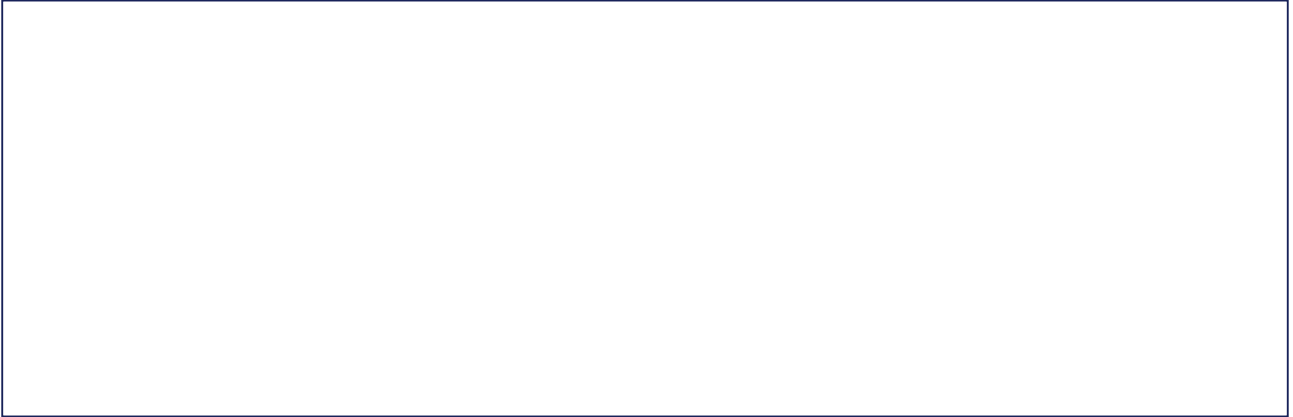
2. Max is playing a game of hopscotch. If he is currently doing the action of jumping on one foot, which spelling is correct: 'hoping' or 'hopping'? Explain why. (2 marks)

3. Max invited a friend to play a song on the violin. Which word from the word bank describes a person who plays music? (1 mark)

4. Max has £5.00. He spent £2.00 on stickers. Write a sentence using the word 'decided' to explain what he did with the rest of his money. (2 marks)

5. Find the two words in the word bank that end in a double consonant. Write them down. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw Max the monkey standing in his shop next to a sign that says 'Max's Maths Shop'. Make sure your spelling on the sign is perfect!



Extension challenge: Can you think of two more words that end in -tion? Write them in a sentence about a trip to a train station.
