

# Pip's Story Adventure Book Review

*Learning objective: To express preferences and opinions about a story, using descriptive language to recount events.*

Help Pip the bookworm celebrate a great story! Read a book together, then use this template to share what you liked best. Encourage the child to think about their favourite character and the most exciting part of the plot.

*Word bank: happy · exciting · funny · scary · adventure · favourite · character · ending*

## 1. Book Title: What is the name of the story you read today?

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## 2. My Favourite Character: Who was your favourite person or animal in the story and why?

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## 3. Best Part: What was the most exciting thing that happened in the story?

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## 4. How I Felt: Use a word from the word bank to describe how the story made you feel.

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## 5. The Ending: Did you like how the story finished? Why or why not?

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*Extension challenge: Ask the child to imagine an alternative ending for the story. How would the characters behave if the ending was different? Draw a picture of your new ending on the back of this sheet.*
