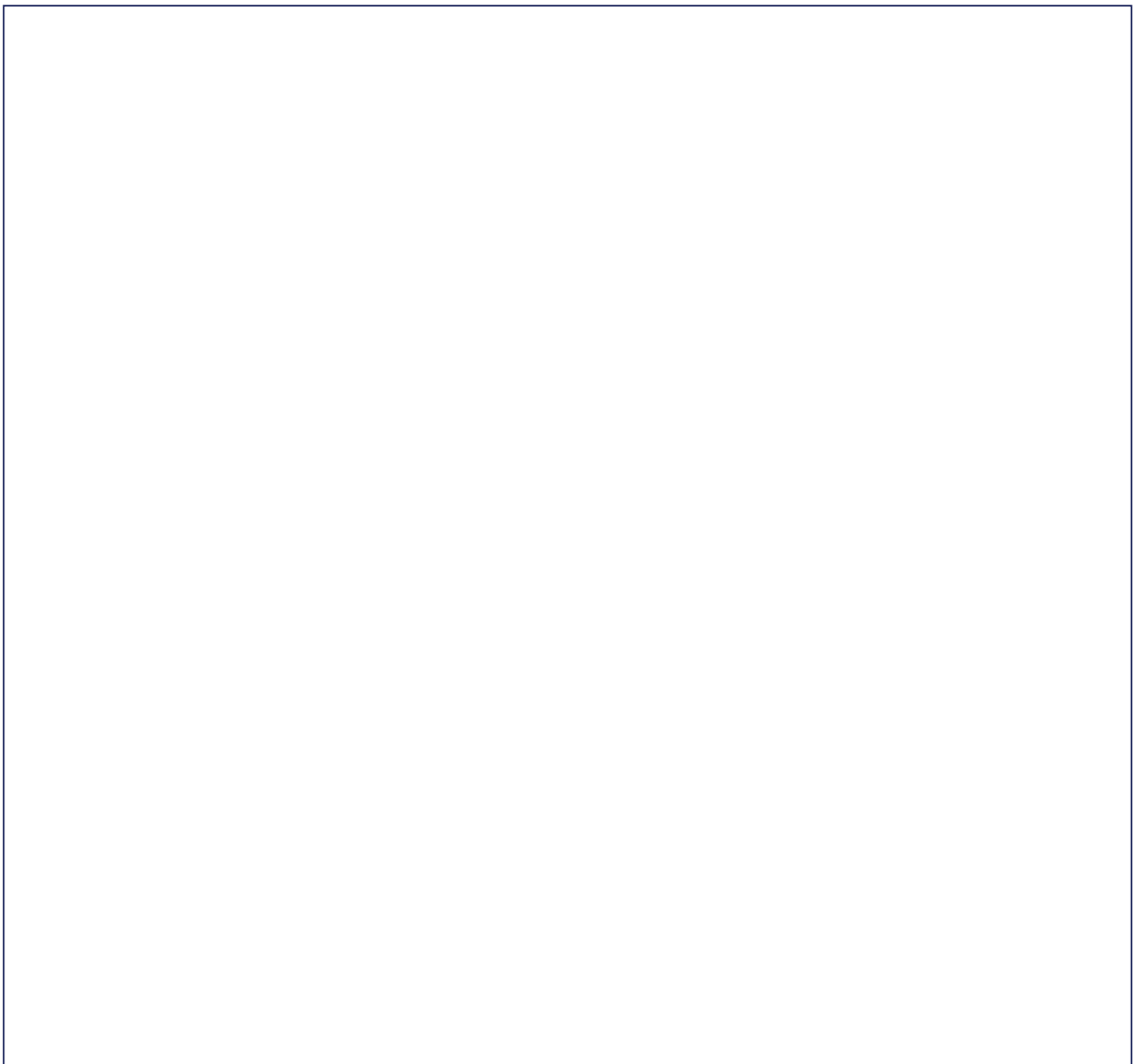


Pip the Bookworm's Story Adventure

Learning objective: To identify key features of a storybook and practise descriptive labelling.

Colour in the scene below and use your imagination to draw your favourite storybook character on the empty page of the open book. Label the parts of the book as shown in the questions.

Colour this: A cosy reading corner scene. In the centre, Pip the cheerful caterpillar with a small green body and a friendly smile is wearing tiny glasses and holding a large, open storybook. The book is resting on a fluffy rug. Next to Pip is a tall bookshelf filled with books of different shapes and sizes. One book is open, showing blank pages for the child to draw on. Steps:
