

Pip's Word Collection Adventure

Learning objective: To use a wider range of vocabulary to describe objects and actions, including adjectives and verbs.

Read each question carefully. Use your best handwriting and remember to use capital letters and full stops where needed.

Pip the caterpillar is busy collecting new words for his secret garden notebook. He loves words that help paint a picture in your mind!

Word bank: enormous · scamper · shimmering · whisper · gigantic · dash · gleaming · mumble

1. Pip saw a very big apple. Which word from the word bank could you use instead of 'big' to make your writing more exciting? (1 mark)

2. If a mouse runs very quickly, it might 'scamper'. Can you write a sentence using the word 'scamper' to describe a small animal? (2 marks)

3. Choose a word from the word bank that describes something shiny. Use it in a sentence about the stars. (2 marks)

4. If you speak very quietly to a friend, you 'whisper'. What is the opposite of a whisper? (Hint: Think about how you talk when you are excited!) (1 mark)

5. Find a partner or think of your own sentence. Can you use the word 'dash' to describe how a cheetah moves across the grass? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a garden where everything is 'enormous'. Draw Pip the caterpillar looking up at a giant flower.



Extension challenge: Can you think of three more words that mean 'happy'? Write them down and share them with a friend.
