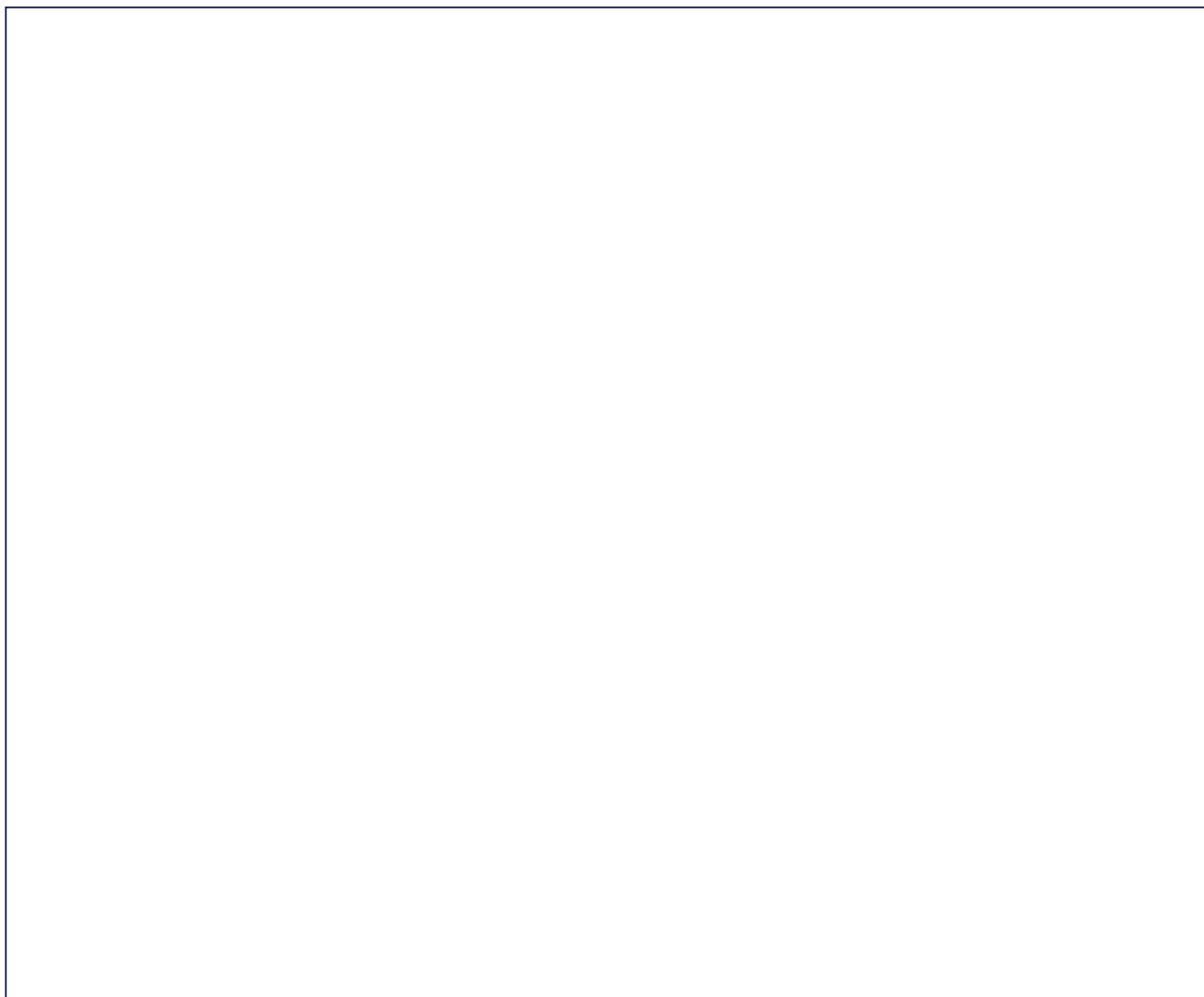


Pip's Magnificent Word Garden

Learning objective: To enhance creative writing by using expanded noun phrases and precise vocabulary to describe a setting.

Pip the caterpillar is building a garden where words grow like flowers. Use the word bank to help you draw and label your own magical garden scene. Think about how you can use adjectives to describe the nouns you draw.

Draw: Draw a magical garden scene where words are part of the landscape. Include a colossal flower, a shimmering stream, and an ancient stone path. In the centre, draw Pip the caterpillar tending to a plant. Use bright, vibrant colours and ensure there is enough space around your objects to write labels. The style should be whimsical and clear.



Label words: vibrant · colossal · shimmering · ancient · fragrant · meticulous · enchanted · kaleidoscope

Steps:

1. Choose one object you have drawn. Write an expanded noun phrase to describe it using at least two adjectives from the word bank (e.g., The shimmering, vibrant butterfly).
2. Pip wants to find a 'colossal' word for a large tree. Can you think of a synonym for 'colossal' that you could use instead?
3. If your garden was 'fragrant', what specific smell might Pip notice? Describe it using a powerful verb.

4. Label your drawing with three of the words from the word bank, drawing an arrow to the part of the garden they describe.
5. Why do you think Pip chose the word 'meticulous' to describe his gardening style? Explain your reasoning.
