Learning objective: To improve writing quality by selecting precise, ambitious synonyms and understanding the nuances between related words to enhance descriptive clarity.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you select the most effective vocabulary, ensuring your sentences are sophisticated and engaging for your reader.

Word bank: Resplendent · Pondered · Exhilarating · Treacherous · Meticulous · Luminous · Gallant · Vast

1. Max is solving a complex maths puzzle. Instead of saying he 'thought about the problem', replace the underlined phrase with a word from the bank that implies deep, careful consideration. Justify why this word is more effective than 'thought'. (2 marks)

2. Finn the dolphin is navigating a dangerous storm. Which word from the bank best describes the sea conditions? Explain why you chose this word over the word 'difficult'. (2 marks)

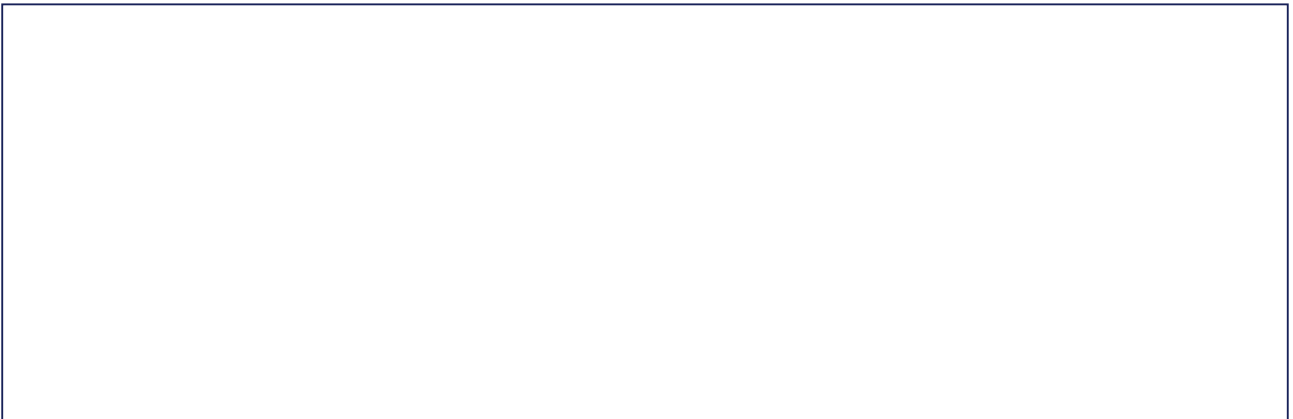
3. Zara is painting a sunset that looks bright and glowing. Choose the most appropriate adjective from the bank to describe the scene. How does this word change the mood of the sentence compared to using the word 'bright'? (2 marks)

4. Nova the owl is known for being extremely careful and precise with her research. Which word from the bank best characterises her approach? Use this word in a new sentence about an explorer. (2 marks)

5. Compare and contrast the words 'Resplendent' and 'Luminous'. In what specific contexts would you use one rather than the other? Give an example for each. (3 marks)

6. What might happen to the tone of a heroic story if you replaced the word 'Gallant' with the word 'brave'? Discuss the impact of using more elevated vocabulary in creative writing. (3 marks)
