

World Book Day with Pip the Bookworm

Learning objective: To develop vocabulary, recall information about favourite stories, and practise early writing skills related to World Book Day.

Read the questions carefully with an adult. Look at the word bank to help you spell your answers. Write your answers on the lines provided.

Word bank: adventure · favourite · character · story · library · book

1. Pip the caterpillar loves to read. What is the title of your favourite book? (1 mark)

2. Who is the main character in your favourite story? (1 mark)

3. Why do you like this story? Is it funny, exciting, or does it have lovely pictures? (2 marks)

4. If you went to the library with Pip, what kind of book would you choose to look for? (e.g., about animals, space, or magic) (2 marks)

5. World Book Day is a time to celebrate reading. Can you think of one place where it is nice to sit and read a book? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself reading your favourite book next to Pip the caterpillar. Make sure to draw the character from your book too!



Extension challenge: Imagine you are writing your own story! Choose a name for your main character and draw what they look like on a piece of paper. Tell your teacher one thing that happens to them in your story.
