

Pip the Caterpillar's World Book Day Adventure

Learning objective: To use adjectives and descriptive language to create a character profile for World Book Day.

Pip the caterpillar is getting ready for World Book Day! He wants to dress up as a brave explorer. Look at the questions below. Use the word bank to help you describe his costume. Write short sentences to finish the description.

Word bank: shiny · golden · bright · soft · brave · woolly · spotted · large

1. Pip needs a hat. What does his hat look like? Start your sentence with: 'Pip has a...' (2 marks)

2. Pip wears a cloak. What colour is it? Use one word from the word bank. Start with: 'His cloak is...' (2 marks)

3. Pip carries a bag. How does the bag feel? Start with: 'The bag feels...' (2 marks)

4. Why is Pip a good explorer? Start with: 'Pip is a...' (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Pip the caterpillar wearing his brave explorer costume. Make sure to draw his hat, his cloak, and his bag.



Extension challenge: Pick your favourite book character. Can you write two sentences about what they are wearing today?
