

My World Book Day Book Review

Learning objective: To express personal opinions about a book and justify them using evidence from the text.

Celebrate World Book Day by sharing your thoughts on a book you have enjoyed. Use the sections below to guide your review. Think about why the author made certain choices and how the story made you feel. You can use the word bank to help describe your reading experience.

Word bank: captivating · suspenseful · vivid · imaginative · characterisation · perspective · thought-provoking · climax · atmosphere

1. Book Details: Record the title, author, and genre of the book you are reviewing. Why did you choose this book for World Book Day? (2 marks)

2. Plot Summary: Write a brief summary of the story in your own words. Remember to avoid spoilers for someone who hasn't read it yet! (3 marks)

3. Character Analysis: Describe your favourite character. What are their main traits, and how do their actions change throughout the story? (4 marks)

4. Personal Reflection: Which part of the book did you find the most exciting or interesting? Explain why you felt this way. (3 marks)

5. Recommendation: Who would you recommend this book to and why? Give a final rating out of five stars. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a brand new cover for this book that captures the main theme or setting of the story.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are Pip the bookworm. Write a short paragraph explaining why this book is a must-read for other book lovers, using at least three words from the word bank.
