Learning objective: To name and identify common animals in French.

Read the sentences about the animals. Look at the word bank to help you. Write the French word for each animal in the spaces provided.

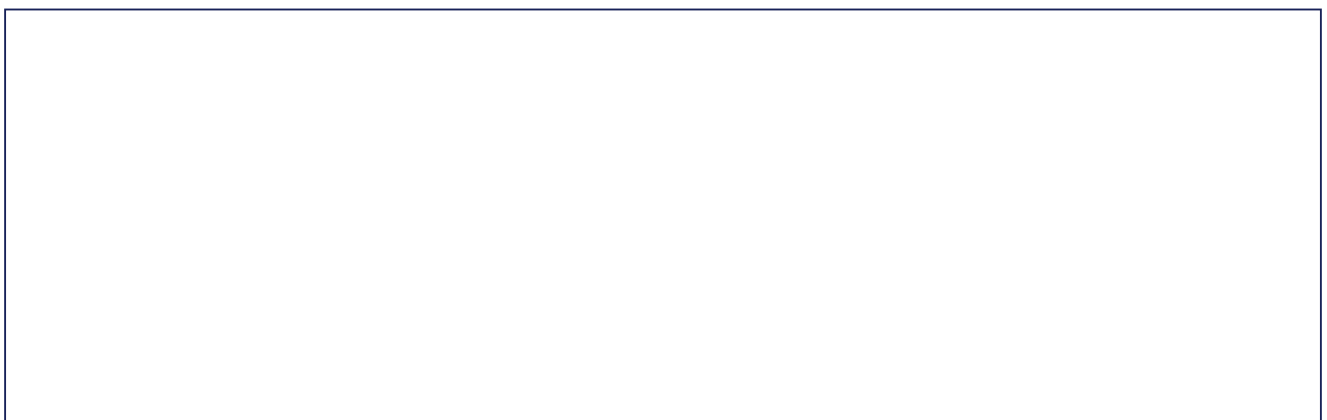
