

Rosa's Animal Kingdom Sketchbook

Learning objective: To identify and label common animals in French and represent them visually.

Follow the drawing prompt to create your own animal scene. Use the word bank to label each animal you have drawn in French. Make sure your illustrations are clear and accurate.

Draw: Create a large, detailed garden scene. In the centre, draw a big tree. Place a bird (*un oiseau*) in the branches and a cat (*un chat*) sitting near the trunk. In the grass, draw a rabbit (*un lapin*) and a mouse (*une souris*). Near a small pond in the corner, draw a fish (*un poisson*) and a turtle (*une tortue*). Use a bright colour palette and ensure each animal is large enough to be clearly labelled.



Label words: un chien · un chat · un lapin · un oiseau · un cheval · un poisson · une souris · une tortue

Steps:

1. Draw an animal that has fur and label it using the correct French term from the word bank.
2. Draw an animal that lives in water and label it using the correct French term.
3. Draw a small animal that might live in a garden and label it.
4. Which animal from the word bank is the largest? Write its name in French.
5. Translate the phrase 'The bird is beautiful' into French using the word bank and your knowledge of adjectives.
