

Rosa's Animal Adventure: Mes Animaux

Join Rosa the parrot as we flutter through the French animal kingdom!

- Le mot 'un' is used for masculine nouns, while 'une' is used for feminine nouns. For example: un chien, une souris.
- To describe an animal as 'big', we use the word 'grand'. To say a rabbit is big, we write: 'Un lapin est grand'.
- To describe an animal as 'small', we use the word 'petit'. To say a bird is small, we write: 'Un oiseau est petit'.
- If you want to say something is 'pretty', use the word 'joli'. For example: 'Un chat est joli'.
- Remember that adjectives in French often change if the noun is feminine (e.g., une souris est petite).

Did you know? Did you know? In French, when you talk about animals, you often use the word 'un' for masculine nouns and 'une' for feminine nouns. Rosa the parrot says: 'Un chien est souvent loyal, et un chat est souvent très indépendant!'
