

French Clothes Assessment: Rosa the Parrot's Wardrobe

Learning objective: To identify and write French vocabulary for items of clothing and use simple phrases to describe what I am wearing.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you. Write your answers in the spaces provided. You can do this!

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a party. She has many colourful clothes to choose from. Help Rosa pick her outfit!

Word bank: un pull (a jumper) · une chemise (a shirt) · un pantalon (trousers) · une robe (a dress) · des chaussures (shoes) · Je porte... (I am wearing...) · bleu (blue) · rouge (red)

1. 1. Look at the word bank. Write the French word for 'trousers'. (2 marks)

2. 2. If Rosa wears a red dress, how do you write that in French? (Hint: 'une robe' + 'rouge') (2 marks)

3. 3. Rosa is wearing a blue jumper. Fill in the gaps: Je porte un _____. (4 marks)

4. 4. Match the English word to the French word by drawing a line or writing the pair: (A) Shirt, (B) Shoes. (4 marks)

5. 5. Rosa wants to wear a shirt and trousers. Write a sentence saying: 'I am wearing a shirt and trousers.' (8 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot wearing a blue jumper and red trousers. Label the jumper 'un pull' and the trousers 'un pantalon'.
