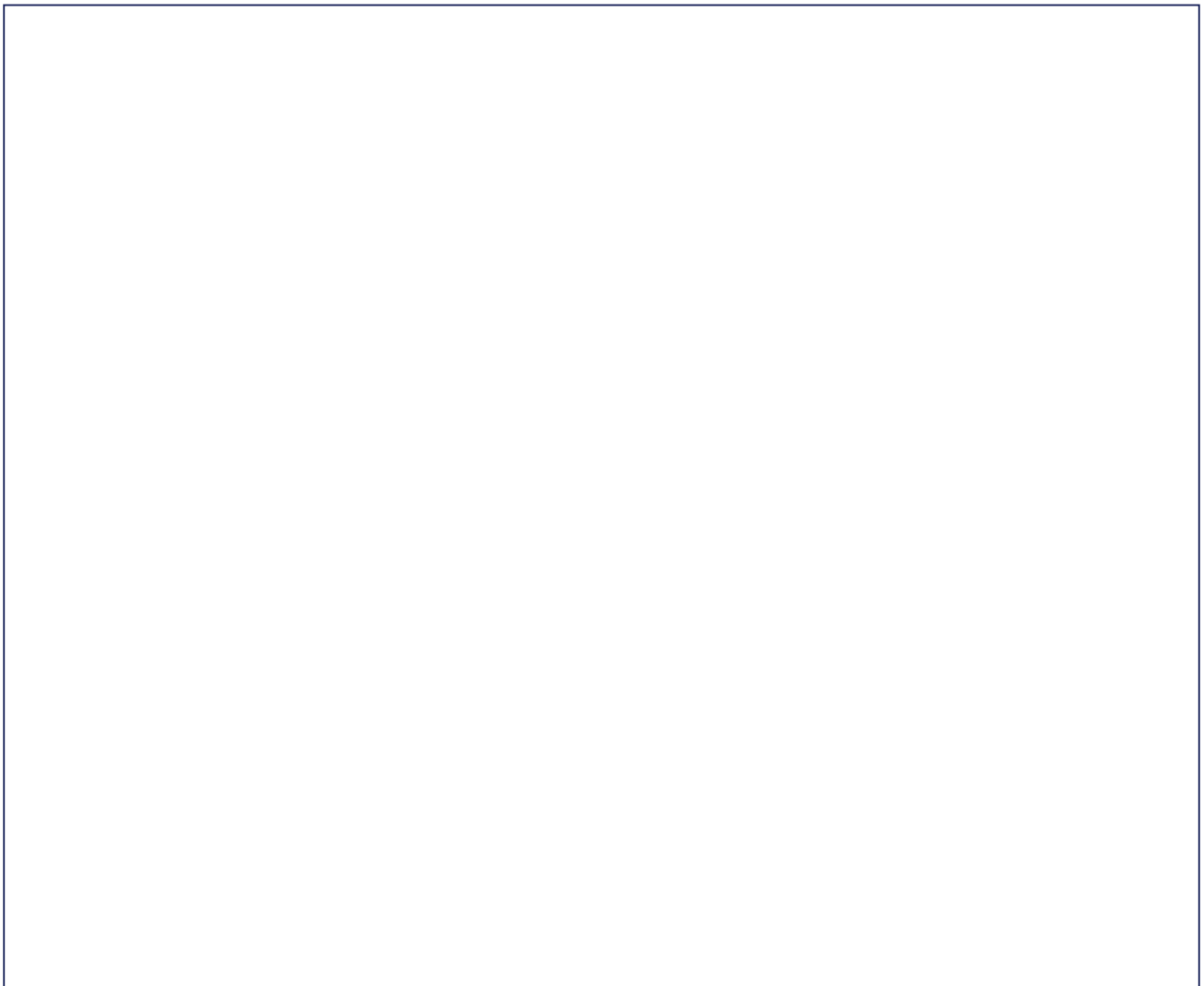


Rosa's French Wardrobe

Learning objective: To learn and use French vocabulary for common items of clothing.

Follow the steps below to draw Rosa the parrot getting ready for a sunny day. Use the French words from the word bank to label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a large, friendly parrot standing in a sunny garden. The style should be bright and colourful. Rosa is getting dressed for an outing, so make sure there is plenty of space around her to draw the clothes listed in the word bank. You can use coloured pencils to make her feathers look vibrant.



Label words: un chapeau (a hat) · un t-shirt (a t-shirt) · un pantalon (trousers) · des chaussures (shoes) · une robe (a dress)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large parrot in the middle of your page. Label her 'Rosa'.
2. Step 2: Draw a hat on Rosa's head. Label it with the French word: 'un chapeau'.
3. Step 3: Draw a t-shirt on Rosa. Label it with the French word: 'un t-shirt'.
4. Step 4: Draw some shoes on Rosa's feet. Label them with the French word: 'des chaussures'.
