

Rosa's Wardrobe: French Clothes

Get dressed for success with Rosa the parrot! Can you learn these French words?

- To say 'I am wearing' in French, we use the phrase: **Je porte.**
- A t-shirt is the same in both languages: **un t-shirt.**
- If you want to talk about your trousers, you say: **un pantalon.**
- When you put on your shoes, you are wearing: **des chaussures.**
- On a chilly day, you might put on: **un pull (a jumper).**

Did you know? Did you know? In France, the word 'un pull' is short for 'un pullover'. It comes from the English words 'pull over', because you pull the jumper over your head to put it on!
