

Rosa's French Clothes Shop

Learning objective: To learn and use vocabulary for clothes in French.

Read the sentences about what Rosa the parrot is wearing. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Follow the sentence starters.

Bonjour! I am Rosa. Today, I am getting ready for a sunny day. I am wearing a colourful hat, a warm jumper, blue trousers, and comfy shoes. In French, I say: 'Je porte un chapeau, un pull, un pantalon et des chaussures.'

Word bank: un chapeau (a hat) · un pull (a jumper) · un pantalon (trousers) · des chaussures (shoes) · Je porte... (I am wearing...)

1. What does 'un pull' mean in English? (1 mark)

2. Translate this sentence into English: 'Je porte un chapeau.' (2 marks)

3. Complete the French sentence for: 'I am wearing trousers.' (Use the word bank to help you). (2 marks)

4. Rosa is wearing shoes. Write the French words for 'shoes'. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot wearing her hat, jumper, trousers, and shoes. Label each item of clothing in French.



Extension challenge: Can you add one more item to your drawing? Look up the French word for 'socks' or 'skirt' to add to your picture.
