

Rosa's Wardrobe Adventure: French Fashion Fun

Learning objective: To identify and use common French vocabulary for items of clothing and understand the use of definite articles (le, la, les).

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a trip around the world! She has laid out her suitcase, but she has mixed up the French names for her clothes. Look at the word bank provided. For each item listed in the questions, write the correct French noun with its matching article (le, la, or les). Use your knowledge of gender to help you decide!

Word bank: le chapeau · la chemise · le pantalon · la jupe · les chaussures · le pull · la robe · les chaussettes

1. Rosa needs to pack her warm woolly jumper for chilly nights. What is the French word for 'the jumper'? (2 marks)

2. Rosa is wearing a smart shirt today. Write the French word for 'the shirt'. (2 marks)

3. It is sunny! Rosa puts on her favourite hat. What is 'the hat' in French? (2 marks)

4. Rosa needs to pack her pair of socks and her pair of shoes. Write the French words for 'the socks' and 'the shoes'. (4 marks)

5. Rosa decides to wear her trousers for the flight. Write the French word for 'the trousers'. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot wearing her favourite outfit from the list above. Label three of the items you have drawn using the correct French words from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Can you write a short sentence in French describing what you are wearing today? For example, you could start with 'Je porte...' (I am wearing...) followed by the item of clothing.
