Learning objective: To identify, write, and use French colour vocabulary correctly.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you. Write your answers clearly on the lines provided.

Rosa the parrot is painting a picture. She has many colourful paints. She uses different colours for her feathers and the flowers in her garden.

Word bank: rouge (red) · bleu (blue) · jaune (yellow) · vert (green) · noir (black) · blanc (white) · orange (orange) · rose (pink)

5. Write 5 short sentences in French describing the colours of objects you see in a garden. Use the pattern: 'Le/La [object] est [colour].' (e.g., Le ciel est bleu.) (9 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a parrot with feathers of three different colours. Label each colour in French.
