

Rosa the Parrot's Weekly French Adventure

Learning objective: To learn the days of the week in French and be able to sequence them correctly.

Read the story below about Rosa the parrot. Use the word bank to help you identify the French names for the days of the week and answer the questions.

Rosa the parrot loves to teach her friends new words. Every week, she follows a busy schedule in the rainforest. On lundi, she reads her favourite books. On mardi, she practises singing. By mercredi, she is ready to fly to the high canopy to meet her friends. On jeudi, she learns new maps, and on vendredi, she paints colourful pictures of the flowers. When samedi arrives, Rosa rests, and on dimanche, she enjoys a delicious breakfast of tropical fruit before the week begins again.

Word bank: lundi (Monday) · mardi (Tuesday) · mercredi (Wednesday) · jeudi (Thursday) · vendredi (Friday) · samedi (Saturday) · dimanche (Sunday)

1. Using the word bank, list the seven days of the week in French in the correct order, starting with Monday. (7 marks)

2. Which day of the week does Rosa spend painting colourful pictures? (1 mark)

3. Rosa says she rests on 'samedi'. Based on the text, what is the English name for this day? (1 mark)

4. If Rosa sings on 'mardi', and she follows the order of the week, which day of the week comes immediately after? (1 mark)

5. Translate the following sentence into English: 'Lundi, je lis un livre.' (Hint: 'Je lis' means 'I read'). (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot's weekly planner. Draw seven colourful clouds, label each one with the correct French day of the week, and draw a small picture inside each cloud showing what activity Rosa does on that day.



*Extension challenge: Write a short sentence in French about what you do on your favourite day of the week.
Example: 'Le samedi, je joue au football.'*
