Learning objective: To identify and write French vocabulary for family members and describe who is in a family.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell the French words. Rosa the Parrot is here to help you!

Rosa the parrot has a big, happy family. She loves to talk about them in French. Here is a list of people in her family: Her father (le père), her mother (la mère), her brother (le frère), and her sister (la sœur).
