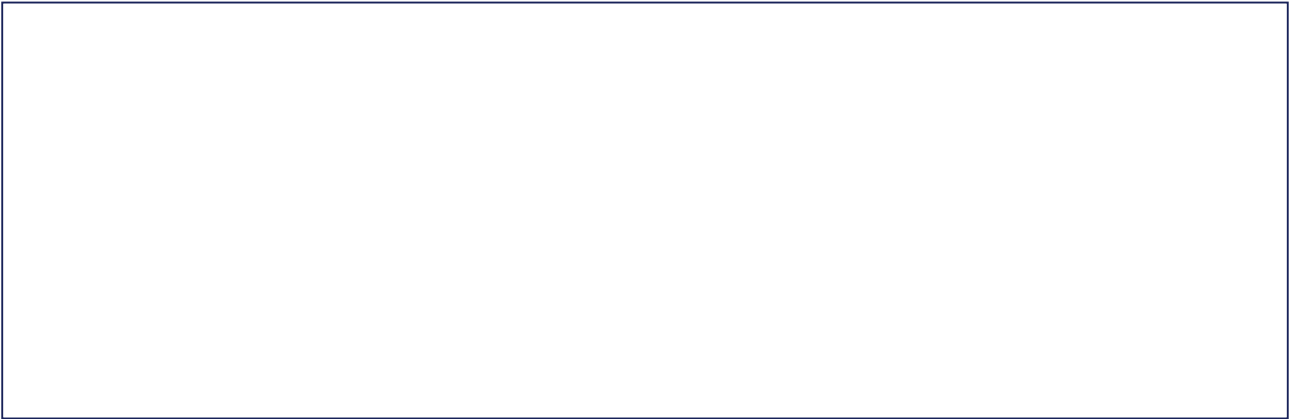
7. 7. How would you say 'the grandmother' in French? (1 mark)
