

Ma Famille - Drawing Activity Sheet

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for family members to create a labelled family tree diagram.

Use the word bank provided to label your family members in French. You may draw your own family, a group of friends, or a fictional family to complete this diagram.

Draw: Create a clear, colourful family tree diagram. Draw a large, sturdy tree with spreading branches. Use circular frames hanging from the branches to represent each family member. Inside each circle, draw a simple portrait of the person. Draw lines connecting the circles to show how the family members are related (e.g., parents at the bottom, grandparents at the top). Use bright colours for the leaves and clear, neat handwriting for the French labels.



Label words: la mère · le père · la sœur · le frère · la grand-mère · le grand-père · le bébé · le cousin · la cousine

Steps:

1. Draw a large tree in the centre of your page. Place your parents at the bottom of the branches and label them using 'la mère' and 'le père'.
2. Add a branch for your siblings. If you have a brother, label him 'le frère'. If you have a sister, label her 'la sœur'.

3. Add two circles at the very top of your tree for your grandparents. Label them 'le grand-père' and 'la grand-mère'.
4. Choose one cousin to add to the side of your tree. Write the correct French label next to them.
5. If there is a baby in your family, draw them near the parents and label them 'le bébé'. If not, draw a pet and write 'mon animal' underneath.
