

French Food Assessment: Le Repas

Learning objective: To identify and write French words for common foods and express likes or dislikes.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you. Write your answers clearly in English or French as requested.

Rosa the parrot is having a picnic in the park. She has a basket full of yummy snacks. She has a piece of bread, some cheese, a red apple, and a piece of chicken. For dessert, she has a cold ice cream.

Word bank: la pomme (apple) · la glace (ice cream) · le pain (bread) · le fromage (cheese) · le poulet (chicken) · J'aime (I like) · Je n'aime pas (I do not like)

1. Look at the passage. List two food items Rosa has in her basket in French. (2 marks)

2. If Rosa likes cheese, how would she say 'I like cheese' in French? (2 marks)

3. If Rosa does not like chicken, how would she say 'I do not like chicken' in French? (2 marks)

4. Rosa wants to buy some bread. The bread costs £2. If she pays with a £5 note, how much change should she get? Show your working out. (4 marks)

5. Rosa is planning a French picnic. Write 5 sentences about what she eats. Use 'J'aime' or 'Je n'aime pas' and the food names. Example: J'aime la pomme. (15 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your own lunchbox. Label at least three items in French using the word bank.
