- To say 'I would like' in French, we say 'Je voudrais'. For example: 'Je voudrais le pain.'
- When we want to talk about food we like, we say 'J'aime...' (I like).
- If you want a drink, you can ask for 'l'eau' or 'le jus d'orange'.
- French cheese is world-famous! In French, we call it 'le fromage'.
- For a healthy snack, you might choose 'une pomme' (an apple).

Did you know? Did you know? In France, the word for a meal is 'le repas'. People in France often enjoy bread with almost every meal of the day!
