

Rosa the Parrot's French Food Café

Learning objective: To learn and use French vocabulary for common food and drink items.

Read the story about Rosa the parrot. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Write your answers in French and English.

Hello! I am Rosa. I love to visit the French café. Today, I am hungry. I look at the menu. I see le pain on a plate. I see une pomme that is red and shiny. I drink le jus d'orange because it is cold. For a treat, I eat le chocolat. It is delicious! What do you like to eat?

Word bank: une pomme (an apple) · le pain (bread) · le chocolat (chocolate) · le jus d'orange (orange juice) · j'aime (I like) · je n'aime pas (I do not like)

2. 2. Write the French for 'an apple'. (1 mark)

3. 3. Finish this sentence: J'aime... (2 marks)

4. 4. Finish this sentence: Je n'aime pas... (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a tray with 'une pomme' and 'le pain' on it. Label your drawing using the French words.
