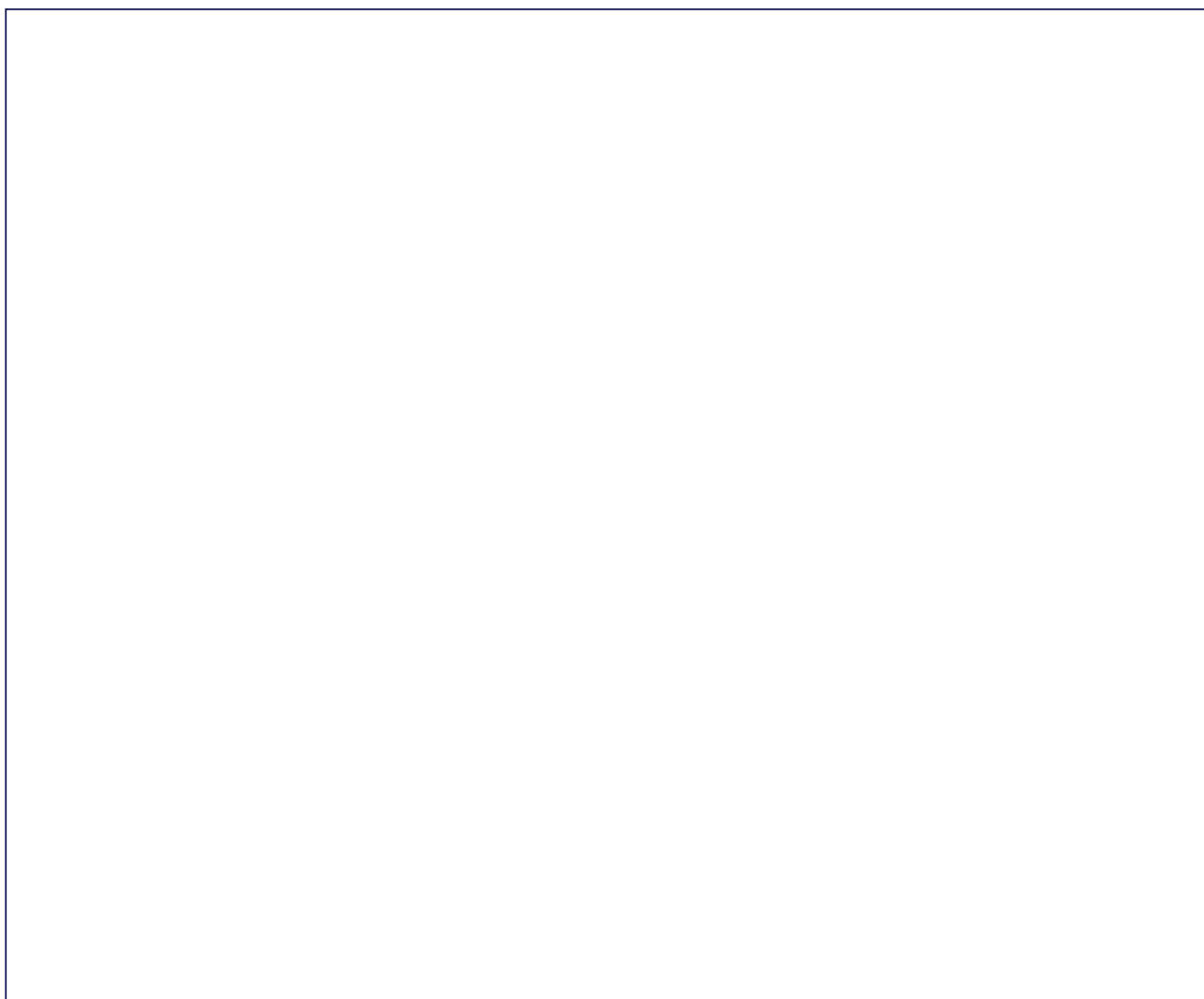


Rosa's French Feast Drawing Sheet

Learning objective: To identify and label common French food items and express preferences using the structure 'J'aime' (I like) and 'Je n'aime pas' (I do not like).

Welcome to the kitchen! Rosa the parrot is hosting a dinner party. Follow the steps below to create a French-inspired menu drawing and label your items correctly using the provided word bank.

Draw: Draw a large kitchen table scene. On the table, illustrate at least four food items from the word bank. Use a neat, clear style so that labels can be drawn clearly with arrows pointing to each food item. Add Rosa the parrot sitting on a chair next to the table looking hungry!



Label words: le pain (bread) · le fromage (cheese) · la pomme (apple) · le poulet (chicken) · les carottes (carrots) · le chocolat (chocolate)

Steps:

1. Label three items on your drawing using the French words from the word bank.
2. Write a sentence in French to say what you like from your drawing, for example: 'J'aime le chocolat.'
3. Write a sentence in French to say what you do not like, for example: 'Je n'aime pas le fromage.'
4. If the bread costs £1.50 and the apple costs £0.50, how much do they cost in total?
5. Why is it important to label your food in the target language when learning French?
