

French Greetings Assessment: Rosa the Parrot's Language Lab

Learning objective: To identify, translate, and use common French greetings and polite phrases.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you. Write your answers clearly on the lines provided.

Rosa the parrot is flying to France! She wants to talk to her friends. Help Rosa learn the right words to say.

Word bank: Bonjour - Hello / Good morning · Salut - Hi / Bye · Au revoir - Goodbye · Comment ça va? - How are you? · Ça va bien - I am well · Merci - Thank you · S'il vous plaît - Please

1. Rosa meets her friend in the morning. What is the polite way to say 'Hello' in French? (Write the French word). (2 marks)

2. Rosa wants to ask her friend how they are feeling. Write the French question for 'How are you?'. (2 marks)

3. Her friend replies that they are well. Write the French phrase for 'I am well'. (2 marks)

4. Rosa is leaving to fly home. Write two different ways to say 'Goodbye' in French. (4 marks)

5. Rosa buys a snack at a shop. Write the French phrase for 'Please' and 'Thank you'. (4 marks)

6. Extended Writing: Imagine you meet a new friend in Paris. Write a short conversation (3 sentences) using greetings and polite words. Start like this: 'Bonjour! Comment ça va? ...' (11 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot waving 'Bonjour' to a friend in a sunny park.
