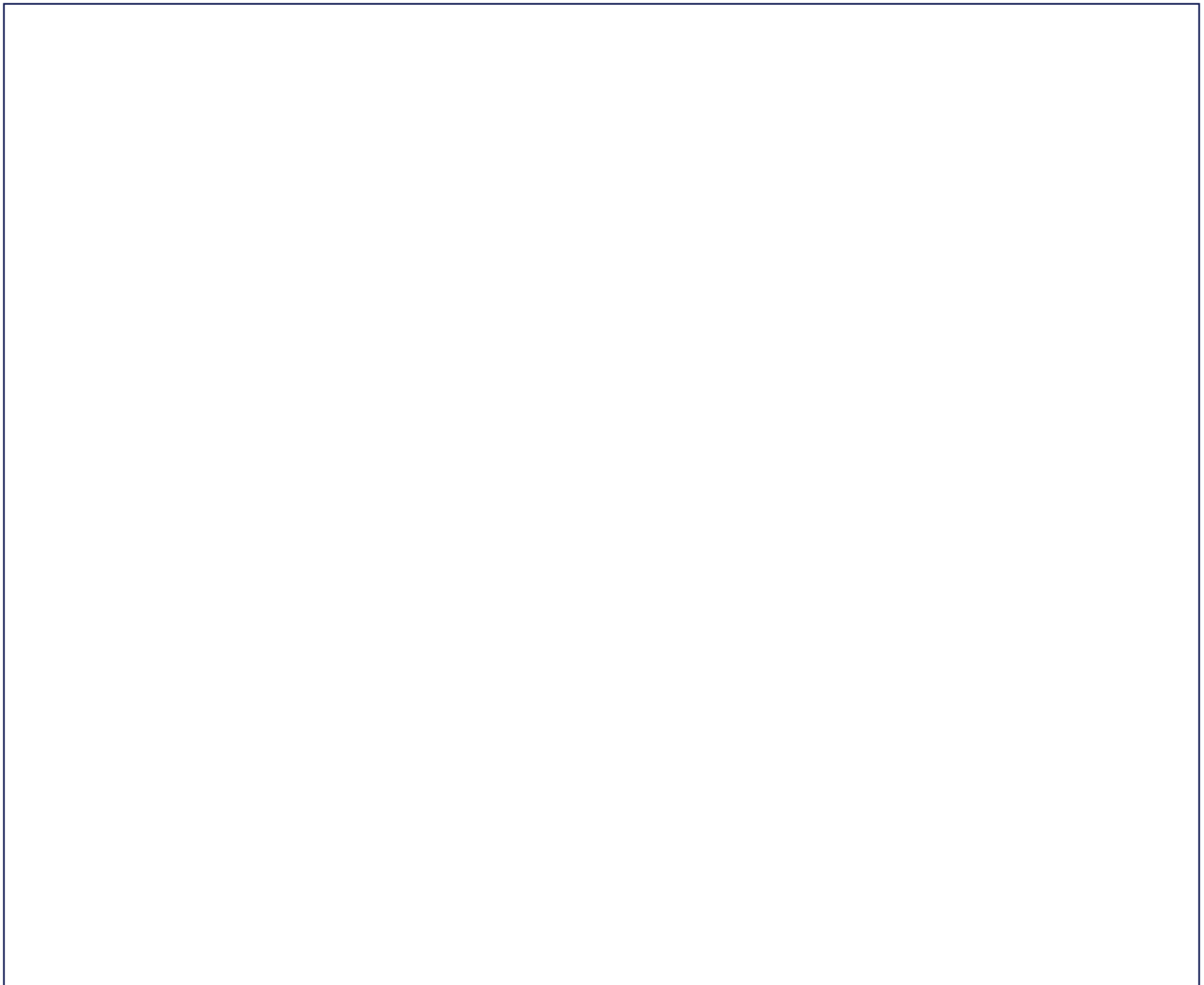


Rosa's Grand French Garden Party

Learning objective: To learn and apply French greetings and polite phrases in a creative context.

Rosa the parrot is hosting a garden party for her friends. Follow the drawing steps to create the scene, then use the word bank to label your characters and their speech bubbles in French.

Draw: Create a vibrant, colourful garden scene. Include Rosa the parrot perched on a branch, greeting her friends. The style should be bright and welcoming, with plenty of flowers, sunshine, and speech bubbles for the characters to speak their French greetings. Ensure there is enough empty space around the characters to write the French phrases clearly.



Label words: Bonjour · Salut · Au revoir · Enchanté · Comment ça va ? · Ça va bien

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Rosa the parrot in the centre of the garden. Label her with a speech bubble saying 'Bonjour'.
2. Step 2: Draw two other BookFlik characters arriving at the party. Label their speech bubbles with a casual 'Salut' and a polite 'Enchanté'.
3. Step 3: Draw a setting sun in the corner. Write 'Au revoir' next to it to show the party is ending.
4. Explain why it is important to choose between 'Bonjour' and 'Salut' depending on who you are talking to. Justify your answer.

5. Compare and contrast the social situations where you would use 'Enchanté' versus 'Comment ça va?'.
6. What might happen if a character used 'Au revoir' as soon as they walked through the front gate? Explain the confusion this would cause.
