

Rosa the Parrot's French Greetings

Learning objective: To learn and use common French greetings.

Read the sentences with Rosa. Use the word bank to help you fill in the gaps. You can do this!

Rosa the parrot loves to travel. She flies to France to visit her friends. When she arrives, she says 'Bonjour' to say hello. She asks her friend, 'Ça va?' which means 'How are you?'. When it is time to fly home, she says 'Au revoir'.

Word bank: Bonjour · Salut · Au revoir · Ça va · Merci

1. Rosa wants to say 'Hello' to a friend. Which word should she use? (2 marks)

2. How do you say 'How are you?' in French? (2 marks)

3. Rosa is leaving to go home. What should she say to her friends? (2 marks)

4. If someone asks 'Ça va?', how might you answer? (Hint: You can say 'Ça va bien' for 'I am well'). (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot waving goodbye to a friend in a sunny French park.



Extension challenge: Practice saying these words out loud with a partner. Can you find out what 'S'il vous plaît' means?
